These girls are both ventilator dependent, fed through a G-tube 24 hours a day since they were three months old. Jada and Selena lived in and out of different hospitals and long-term care facilities such as Thomas Jefferson University Hospital for a period of three months and Temple University Children's P.I.C.U. another three months. Then we decided to put them in Second Breath for a year and a half but they were not providing the same type of care that was adequate for our daughters. At this time we were ready to take them home. So we took them to live with us at home with homecare nurses. Jada and Selena lived with us for two years then the nursing fell apart, so we had to evacuate them to another long-term care facility where they lived for one year. While they were there, we had to call different places like Keystone Mercy to complain about the abuses that our daughters had to endure. We really can go on telling you horror stories also we have the proof of everything we have said about the place we had them. The way they left there was through an emergency evacuation to Thomas Jefferson University Hospital where they spent the next six months.

Everyday that our daughters spent at the hospital we wanted them to go to Pedia Manor. Because of an insurance reason it took five months for this dream to finally come true on January 14, 2004 our girls left the hospital to go to Pedia Manor. This home speaks for itself as soon as you come through its many doors. This home was once the Second Breath home where our daughters lived. To see all of the changes that were done for the better by Dinesh Singh, Director of Pedia Manor was just amazing. It looks like a new home. That's only on the outside.
